

As your state senator, I want to share an important update.

Following strong objections from myself and other public officials, PECO has announced it will withdraw its request to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for a rate increase.

This is a meaningful win for residents and businesses.

As recently as January 2025, PECO implemented rate increases of 10% for electricity and 12.5% for natural gas. Since then, the company's revenue has increased significantly.

Given that, asking for another increase – totaling hundreds of millions of dollars – simply wasn't justified, especially with the rising cost of living.

PECO has indicated that ongoing financial pressures on customers, along with the need to prioritize affordability, led to its decision to withdraw the request.

Please know that I will continue advocating to ensure taxpayers' voices are heard and that affordability remains a top priority in Harrisburg.
